

COLUMN NAME	CONTENT KEY
service_date	Input the date the trip was started; mm/dd/yyyy
duration_hours	Input the time duration of the trip in hours; decimal values are ok
qualified_service_date	Input the calendar day the trip qualified; this is typically the same as the service date, but could be different in certain overnight circumstances
vessel_name	Type the name of vessel exactly as it appears in SeaLog; be sure to add vessels before importing
water_bodies	names of the waters your trip passed through or visited; this is required content for the CG-719S, but also needs to be edited to a reasonable degree of specificity
route_category	Input one of the only options for this required field; Inland, Near Coastal, Oceans, Great Lakes
role_served	Try to use common roles like operator, master, mate, crew, or owner-operator
attester_name	Input the name of the person that can attest to your sea service
attester_role	Input the role of the attester; typically owner, operator, master
attester_phone	Add an attester phone number so you can reach them to attest when you submit for review; use XXX-XXX-XXXX as a format
attester_email	Add an attester email address so you have options for contacting them later when you need a signature
imported_record	Make these "true" or "false" entries; this flags records as imported-only in contrast to records recorded by SeaLog
import_mode	Use the term duration_only for imported trips; leave it blank if the imported_record field has a "false" value
